Just a reminder that pictures for your students will take place on August 31st. This is a little early compared to past years.

Attendance, Tardy and Early dismissal:

Last year our buildings attendance increased from 94.6% to 95.8% This was a very positive increase. Our building goal is to be above 96% for this upcoming school year. There is a direct link between attendance and student growth, therefore, we want to continue to improve our attendance rate. Please be familiar with the school's attendance policy. This can be found on the folders that were sent home with your child during open house, or if you were unable to attend open house ,the folder was sent home with your child the first day of school. Below is a reminder of our tardy and early dismissal policy.

EXCESSIVE Tardies/ Early dismissals will be filed on in court this year. A letter will be created to request a meeting with the parent once 10 of either, tardy or early dismissals have occurred.

Once a student reaches 20 unexcused tardies and/or early dismissals court intervention will be taken. The only EXCUSED TARDIES/EARLY DISMISSALS are the same as the excused absences. Doctor note, funeral card, lice check or school related activity.

Calling office when your child is absent:

Please notify office when your child will be absent. You may do this between 8:30 am and 10:30 am, or by sending a signed note with sibling. This is required procedure as stated in the Missing Children Act. If you are unable to contact the office by 10:30 am you will receive an automated phone call from the school district notifying you to inform the school of your child's absence.

PTO/ AR Prizes

The prizes that students will receive for obtaining their AR goal has changed this year. Student's that achieve their AR goal all four nine weeks will receive a t-shirt.

Kroger Rewards

Before Care and After Care

If you are interested about signing up your child for Project SAFE, there are two ways to register. 1. Come to the board office to fill out the paperwork or, 2. go to www.loganhocking.k12.oh.us/projectsafe. Hocking Hills Elementary no longer takes registration forms or payments. Project Safe is now using My School Bucks as one option for parents to make their tuition payments. Before care begins at 6:30 am and after care will end at 5:30 pm.

MySchoolBox.com

Logan Hocking School District offers a program for parents to help them monitor your child's lunch account. The system is called MySchoolBox.com. This website will allow parents the ability to access their child's account. It offers the following features:

Automatic deposit when your child's account is running low.

Your child's purchase history from the past 90 days.

Low balance e-mail notifications

Schedule recurring payments

An app you can download for your mobile device.
